## ***Regenerate - the Event***



The event kicked off with food and drinks in the cafeteria area. Pizza, soda and chips were served as teenagers poured on to the grounds.

Hip-hop artist Bobby Bishop took the stage and brought the crowd to their feet as he engaged them with his music.

The Patrick Lynch band also led us in a time of worship before and after the gospel was presented.

Because of Willimantic's hispanic population, the entire event was presented in English and Spanish. Janiel Caraballo served as the interpreter for the event. Laura Callicutt, a



Teen Challenge success story shared her story about how she came to Christ and how Christ helped her overcome drugs for the last two years.

During the message, Tom Miyashiro shared the powerful story of how his wife, Amy came to faith in Christ several years before dying of brain cancer. He talked about how her faith in Christ carried her from this life to the next. He challenged students to consider who or what they are living for and drove home the point that there is something greater to live for in Christ that is bigger than this life.



After presenting the gospel clearly, there was an opportunity for teenagers to respond to the message. In all, 18 decisions were made and 2 were for the first time. Counselors were trained and ready with materials to pray with students and collect their information for follow up.

Patrick Lynch closed the night out with powerful worship as we celebrated the decisions were made. Regenerate was a great testimony to God's power and also to the great things that can be accomplished when Christ's body works together.
